ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)
AMENDED BY THE
ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
(AVENUE ROAD, ACTON, LONDON W3)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND WAITING
RESTRICTION)
(NOTICE OF INTENT)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Ealing being the traffic authority for Avenue Road, Acton, London W3, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate repair works to collapsed foul water sewer, outside property no.111, it intends to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding and waiting on part of the said road, which extends between the western kerb line of Langley Drive and a point opposite to western boundary of property no.116.
2. No person shall, until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle, on the said length of Avenue Road: -
 - a) to proceed;
 - b) to wait, load or unload on both sides.
3. Existing, west to east only one - way working, conditions, laid by permanent Traffic Management Order on that length of Avenue Road, which extends between its junctions with Langley Drive and Gunnersbury Lane, would be temporarily suspended and made two-way working to maintain local residents' access at all times.
4. If any unanticipated increase in intensity of traffic flow occurs while the said works and temporary prohibitions are in force, waiting would be temporarily imposed either on the north or south side within that length of Avenue Road, which would be made two-way working, to maintain safer and uninterrupted traffic flow.
5. Whilst the temporary restrictions (operative at any time) remain in force displaced vehicular traffic
 - a) intending to travel east should proceed via Gunnersbury Lane, Bollo Bridge Road, Newton Avenue and Avenue Road;
 - b) should follow advance warning and diversion signs displayed and any other traffic management in place wherever necessary on site to reach their desired destination.
6. Nothing in the proposed Order shall apply to any thing done: -
 - a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer;
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - c) to any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - d) to any resident / business seeking access up to the limits of the immediate restricted points insofar as the said works allow.
7. The Order, which would have a maximum duration of 18 months, would come into operation on Friday 15th August 2008. The said works and restrictions are proposed to commence on Friday 15th August 2008 and are expected to be completed within 2 weeks.
