CLOSURE OF BARNHAM ROAD AT ITS JUNCTION WITH FARNDALE CRESCENT AND ASSOCIATED NO WAITING AT ANY TIME RESTRICTIONS

THE EALING (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 92) TRAFFIC ORDER 2008

THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 353) ORDER 2008

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing on the 6th August 2008 made the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders will be to continue in force the following measures which have been in force as an experiment
 - (a) the closure of Barnham Road to vehicles (other than pedal cycles, emergency service vehicles and certain other vehicles) at its junction with Farndale Crescent by means of a lockable gate. Pedal cycles are provided with a route past the gate in both directions.
 - (b) the imposition of waiting restrictions applying at any time in the lengths of Barnham Road and Farndale Crescent specified in the Schedule to this notice.
3. The Orders, which will come into operation on 8th August 2008, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available for inspection during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, until the 17th September 2008 .
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 17th September 2008.

SCHEDULE

Barnham Road

- (a) the north-east side, between its junction with Farndale Crescent and a point 8.20 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 2 and 4 Barnham Road;
- (b) the south-west side, between its junction with Farndale Crescent and a point 8.50 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 3 Barnham Road.

Farndale Crescent (the north-east to south-west arm) the north-west side, between a point 7.00 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Barnham Road and a point 7.00 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Barnham Road.
