1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing on the 6th August 2008 made the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order will be to extend the "at any time" waiting restriction in Whitton Avenue at its junction with Whitton Close by 4 metres on either side.
3. The general effect of the Sudbury Town Parking Places Order will be to remove the first 4 metres of the permit places either side of Whitton Close.
4. The general effect of the Hanger Hill Parking Places Order 2008 will be to redefine the permit parking places outside Nos. 18 and 20 Clarendon Gardens so that there is a continuous parking place outside these premises.
5. The Orders, which will come into operation on the 11th August 2008, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available for inspection during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, until the 17th September 2008.
6. Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to any of the Orders may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 17th September 2008.
