

LONDON BOROUGH OF EALING

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 (WOODFIELD ROAD, EALING, LONDON W5) (TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTION) (NOTICE OF MAKING)

1. London Borough of Ealing, being the traffic authority for Woodfield Road, Ealing, London W5, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate safer access for the vehicles involved in the supply of building materials and disposal of waste at an adjacent Nursing Home construction site at property no. 23 (Chestnut Lodge), it has made an Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from waiting on part of the said road, which extends between the northern kerb line of Mount Avenue and a point opposite to common boundary of property nos. 10 & 12.
2. No person shall, until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload on western side of the said length of Woodfield Road.
3. Whilst the temporary restrictions (operative on Mon - Fridays between 08.30 hrs - 17.00 hrs, remain in force, displaced vehicular traffic should follow advance signs displayed and any other traffic management (including the guidance of banksman) in place wherever necessary on site to reach their desired destination or to find alternative parking places.
4. Nothing in the Order shall apply to anything done: -
 - a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer;
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - c) to any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - d) to any local resident / business seeking access up to the limits of the immediate restricted points insofar as the said works allow.
5. The Order, which will have a maximum duration of 18 months, will come into operation on Monday 28th July 2008. The said works are scheduled to commence on Monday 28th July 2008 and are expected to be completed within 12 months.
