ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 (COWLEY ROAD, ACTON, LONDON W3) (TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) (NOTICE OF INTENT)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Ealing being the traffic authority for Cowley Road, Acton, London W3, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate shop-front construction works to Tesco Metro retail shop within a newly built high rise building, "Issigonis House", at the south eastern corner of the junction of The Vale and Cowley Road, it intends to make an Order, the effect of which would be to prohibit pedestrian traffic from proceeding on part of the said road, which extends between the southern kerb line of The Vale and a point opposite to common boundary of unit (property) nos. 1 & 2.
2. No person shall, until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any pedestrian to proceed on the east side footway of the said length of Cowley Road.
3. Whilst the temporary restrictions (operative "at any time") remain in force displaced pedestrian traffic should follow advance warning and diversion signs displayed and any other traffic management in place wherever necessary on site to reach their desired destination.
4. Nothing in the proposed Order shall apply to any thing done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer;
5. The Order, which would have a maximum duration of 18 months, would come into operation on Monday 7th July 2008. The said works are proposed to commence on Monday 7th July 2008 and are expected to be completed within 7 weeks.
