ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16(A) AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994

(HIGH STREET, THE VALE AND CROWN STREET, ACTON, LONDON W3) (TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL EVENTS) (ACTON CARNIVAL PROCESSION) ORDER 2008 (SATURDAY 12th JULY 2008)

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Ealing (hereinafter referred to as "the Council" being the traffic authority for High Street, The Vale and Crown Street, Acton, London W3, in the said London Borough is satisfied that vehicular traffic on parts of the said roads as specified in the schedule to this Order, should be temporarily prohibited from waiting by reason of "Acton Carnival Procession" special event being conducted thereon through the said lengths of the roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council in exercise of its powers under section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Special Events) Act 1994, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order, which will have a maximum duration of 3 days, shall come into operation on Saturday 12th July 2008 and may be cited as **Ealing (Crown Street, High Street and The Vale, Acton, London W3) (Temporary Waiting Restriction) Acton Carnival 2008.**
2. No person shall, until the said event has been completed, cause or permit, any vehicular traffic to wait, load or unload on both sides of the said lengths of the road as specified in this Order.
3. The said procession will commence from Crown Street and proceed through High Street, The Vale and will be completed at Acton Park (near Eastman Road / Centre Avenue).
4. To facilitate the procession leaving Crown Street and entering High Street Acton W3, the No Right Turn sign will be temporarily suspended for the duration of the procession leaving Crown Street only.
5. The temporary restrictions will be operative between 08.00 hrs -14.30 hrs
6. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done: -
 - a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer;
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - c) to any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said event.
7. Waiting restrictions are scheduled to be in place from 08.00 hrs and the said procession is scheduled to commence at 13.00 hrs on Saturday 12th July 2008. Both the waiting restriction and the procession are expected to be completed at 14.30 hrs on the same day.

SCHEDULE Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions on both sides (08.00 hrs -14.30 hrs)

Crown Street	W3, entire length;
High Street	W3, between Crown Street and the network rail overhead bridge (near Birkbeck Road);
The Vale	W3, between the network rail overhead bridge (near Birkbeck Road) and the western kerb line of Eastman Road.
