## WORCESTER GARDENS ROAD HUMP AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS

### The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. \*\*) Order 2008

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order would be to impose double yellow line waiting restrictions applying at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
3. THE COUNCIL ALSO PROPOSE under the powers of section 90c of the Highways Act 1980 to introduce an additional round top road hump in Worcester Gardens outside Nos. 2 and 4 with a nominal height of 75 mms and longitudinal width of 3.70 metres.
4. The Order and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, of the road hump are available for inspection during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the offices of Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order.

Any objections or other representations about the proposed Order or the traffic calming measures should be sent in writing to the Council's agents, Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, quoting reference ORD 3421/djc until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
