ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 (SOUTHFIELD ROAD, CHISWICK, LONDON W4) (TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTION) (NOTICE OF INTENT)

1. London Borough of Ealing being the traffic authority for Southfield Road, Chiswick, London W4, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE, that to facilitate replacement of damaged telecommunication pole belongs to British Telecom, outside property no.224, it intends to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from waiting, loading and unloading on part of the said road, which extends between the eastern kerb line of Acton Lane and a point opposite to common boundary of property nos. 171 & 173.
2. No person shall, until the said works have been completed, cause or permit, any vehicle to wait, load or unload on south side of the said length of Southfield Road.
3. Whilst the temporary restrictions (operative between 08.30 hrs - 16.30 hrs) remain in force displaced vehicular traffic should follow advance warning signs displayed and any other traffic management in place wherever necessary on site to find alternative parking places.
4. Nothing in the proposed Order shall apply to any thing done: -
 - a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer;
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - c) to any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - d) to any local resident / business seeking access up to the limits of the immediate restricted points insofar as the said works allow.
5. The Order, which would have a maximum duration of 18 months, would come into operation on Sunday 7th September 2008. The said works are proposed to commence at 08.30 hrs on Sunday 7th September 2008 and are expected to be completed at 16.30 hrs on the same day.
