ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16(A) AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 (VARIOUS ROADS AROUND GUNNERSBURY PARK, ACTON, LONDON W3) (TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL EVENTS) (LONDON MELA) ORDER 2008 (SUNDAY 10th AUGUST 2008)

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Ealing, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') being the traffic authority for various roads around Gunnersbury Park, Acton, London W3, as specified in schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order, in the said London Borough and with the consent of the London Borough of Hounslow in respect of those roads in schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order for which that Borough is the traffic authority, is satisfied that vehicular traffic on parts of the said roads should be temporarily prohibited from proceeding, by reason of London Mela 2008 summer event being held at Gunnersbury Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council in exercise of its powers under 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Special Events) Act 1994, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Notice, which will have a maximum duration of 3 days, shall come into operation on Sunday 10th August 2008 and may be cited as Ealing (Various Roads Around Gunnersbury Park, Acton, London W3) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic, Temporary Waiting, Loading, Unloading and Parking Restrictions) Notice 2008.
2. No person shall, until the said event has been completed, cause or permit any vehicle:
 - a) To enter or exit from the South Ealing Road, Popes Lane, Gunnersbury Avenue and Gunnersbury Lane ends of the roads specified in schedule 1;
 - b) To proceed on entire lengths of roads specified in schedule 2;
 - c) To turn right as specified in schedule 3.
3. Whilst the temporary restrictions and prohibitions remain in force displaced vehicular traffic should follow advance warning and diversion signs displayed or any other traffic management in place to reach their desired destination.
4. Local residents' vehicular access will be maintained at all times. Local residents those who hold a valid London Mela 2008 Event Permit can be allowed to park their vehicle in their respective roads. Pedestrians will not be affected.
5. Nothing in this Notice shall apply to any thing done: -
 - a) With the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer;
 - b) To any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - c) To any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said event.
6. The said event is scheduled to commence at 06.00 AM on Sunday 10th August 2008 and is expected to be completed at 11.00 PM on the same day.

SCHEDULE 1 (No Entry / Exit) (Operative between 06.00 AM-11.00PM on Sunday 10th August 2008)

- Sunderland Road and Durham Road from South Ealing Road;
- Olive Road, Rose Gardens, Cedar Grove, Lionel Road North, Beech Gardens, Ash Grove, Elderberry Road, Knight's Avenue and Baronsmede from Popes Lane;
- Kingsbridge Avenue, Baronsmede, Tudor Way, Ridgeway Drive, The Ridgeway, Park Drive, Park Place Drive, Princes Avenue. Park Way, Park Place and Manor Gardens from Gunnersbury Avenue;
- Lillian Avenue, Gunnersbury Gardens, Gunnersbury Crescent and Princes Avenue from Gunnersbury Lane.

SCHEDULE 2 (Prohibition of Traffic)

- (Operative between 06.00 AM -11.00 PM on Sunday 10th August 2008)
- the entire lengths of Elderberry Road, Park Drive, Carbery Avenue and Kingsbridge Avenue;
- Lionel Road North, between Popes Lane and junction with Great West Road (A4).

SCHEDULE 3 (No Right Turn)

- (Operative between 06.00 AM -11.00 PM on Sunday 10th August 2008)
- From northern arm of Gunnersbury Avenue into Popes Lane;
- From Popes Lane into Gunnersbury Avenue.
