ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 (QUEEN ANNE'S GROVE, CHISWICK, LONDON W4) (TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURE) (NOTICE OF INTENT)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Ealing being the traffic authority for Queen Anne's Grove, Chiswick, London W4, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate construction works at an adjacent property development site, "The Cloisters", situated between property nos. 20 & 22, it intends to make an Order, the effect of which would be to temporarily prohibit pedestrians from proceeding on part of the said road, which extends between a point opposite to common boundary of property nos. 18 & 20 and another point opposite to common boundary of property nos. 22 & 24.
2. No person shall, until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any pedestrian to proceed on the east side footway of the said length of Queen Anne's Grove.
3. Whilst the temporary restrictions (operative "at any time") remain in force displaced pedestrians should follow advance warning and diversion signs displayed and any other traffic management in place wherever necessary on site to reach their desired destination.
4. Nothing in the proposed Order shall apply to any thing done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a police community support officer;
5. The Order, which would have a maximum duration of 18 months, would come into operation on Monday 18th August 2008. The said works are proposed to commence on Monday 18th August 2008 and are expected to be completed within 2 months.
