

Taxicard Criteria – As of January 2012

<p>Automatic Eligibility Criteria</p>	<p>You are automatically eligible for a Taxicard if you receive:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DLA at Higher Rate Mobility Allowance or • 8 points or more for the moving around activity component of the PIP benefit or • Receive a War Pensioners Mobility Allowance or • Are registered blind or partially sighted
<p>Discretionary Eligibility</p>	<p>If you are not automatically eligible, you may be asked to attend a mobility assessment with an Occupational Therapist who will assess whether you have a disability which keeps you from walking and traveling independently. If you have a disability, and your circumstances fall within Bands A, B or C (see below) you will qualify for a discretionary Taxicard.</p>
<p>Band A 104</p>	<p>You may be awarded 104 trips if you are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unable to use public transport independently or • Have significant difficulty in using public transport for the majority of your journeys, and/ or cannot use public transport for some particular journeys • You are unable to drive and there is no one on whom you can regularly rely on for passenger transport in a car. <p>Note: You can apply for additional trips at the director's discretion.</p>
<p>Band B 52</p>	<p>You may be awarded 52 trips if you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unable to use public transport independently or • Have significant difficulty in using public transport for the majority of your journeys and / or cannot use public transport for some particular journeys, though you can drive most of the time and/ or • Can regularly rely on someone for passenger transport in a car.
<p>Band C 26</p>	<p>You may be awarded 26 trips if you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can use public transport for the majority of your journeys but have occasionally difficulty in doing so and / or cannot use public transport for some particular journeys • You are unable to drive and/ or Do not have anyone on whom I can regularly rely on for passenger transport in a car.
<p>Subsidy</p>	<p>Subsidies are as below, depending on the time of day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • From 6am - 8pm Monday - Friday: £8.30 • From 8pm -10pm Monday - Friday & from 6am -10pm Saturday - Sunday: £9.30 • From 10pm - 6am Monday - Sunday: £10.80
