



This map does not indicate entitlement for a permit or voucher. Please refer to the 'Addresses eligible for permits and/or visitor vouchers'. All eligible addresses in each controlled parking zone (CPZ) will be listed in this section.

The map is only a guideline to show the roads contained within the CPZ. It does not mean that all residents within each CPZ are entitled to a permit.

Some properties that are shown on the map fall within a 'Low Car Housing Scheme' development, as defined by the Council's planning policy (UDP policy 9.8 and SPD 3). If a property is part of a low car housing scheme this means there is either no off-street parking provision or not enough for all the units within the development.

The Council decided to allow the development to go ahead on the basis that an agreement would be entered into providing that no occupier of the development or their visitor, would be entitled to apply for a permit for the controlled parking zone within which the development is located, thus ensuring that there would be no increase in demand for on-street parking. The "Low Car Housing Scheme" overrides any entitlement or eligibility for a permit or voucher.
