

<b><u>Overview of kitchen facilities for HMOs</u></b>	
<b>1 - 5 Occupiers</b>	<p>A cooker with 4 rings or hot plates together with a grill and an oven.</p> <p>4 power points shall be provided per set of kitchen facilities.</p> <p>This requirement is in addition to any points used by an electric cooker or oven or refrigerator.</p> <p>Minimum 0.5m of work top plus 0.5m per household</p> <p>Each household shall be provided with a kitchen cupboard for storage of dry goods, at least 0.3m<sup>3</sup> capacity. The cupboard under the sink is not an acceptable food store.</p> <p>Refrigerator storage must be at least 0.13m<sup>2</sup> per person.</p> <p>Each household should have shelf within a fridge whether this is within their room or in a shared kitchen</p> <p>1 sink minimum size 560mm x 430mm and a drainer shall be provided per 5 persons</p>
<b>6 - 10 Occupiers</b>	2 complete sets of cooking facilities
