

EAL FEE BANDS AND CHARGES 2021/22

Charges to learners are made up of the following elements:

	ESFA/GLA concessions apply to this.	
Course Fee	Fully funded - no course fee Co-funded - 50% of the aim value, e.g. the funding received Concession fee - 25% off the co-funded fee for priority groups which do not qualify for co-funded fee, e.g. elderly social inclusion, disabilities, etc. Non accredited ESOL - no course fee Accredited ESOL - in order to meet the needs of the community, learners enrolled on ESOL classes will only pathe exam registration fee at £25 per unit per term to a total £75 for the year.	
Administration Fee	£6 is included in the fees.	

Learners may apply for learner support funds towards some of the cost of their course, this may include fees, books, equipment, transport, exam fees, and materials.
