Charges to learners are made up of the following elements:

Learners may apply for learner support funds towards some of the cost of their course, this may include fees, books, equipment, transport, exam fees, and materials.

| E | Courses whose primary purpose is personal and/or professional development activity | From £3.70 to £5.00ph |
