

EALING COUNCIL NOTICE OF CONCLUSION OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Ealing Council has concluded its review into polling districts and polling places for the new ward arrangements that come into force from the Local Council Elections to be held on Thursday 5 May 2022.
2. The new ward arrangements were finalised following a review of Ealing ward arrangements undertaken by The Local Government Boundary Commission for England (LGBCE). Full details of Ealing's new ward arrangements can be found by visiting the LGBCE website at <https://www.lgbce.org.uk/all-reviews/greater-london/greater-london/ealing>
3. The consultation period for the review of polling districts and polling places for the new ward arrangements took place between 17 September 2021 and 18 October 2021.
4. At a meeting of Boundaries Panel held on the 4 November 2021, the Council resolved to approve the new polling districts and polling places.

The new polling districts and polling place designations have been published by the (Acting) Returning Officer, the details of which can be viewed in detail by visiting <https://www.ealing.gov.uk/elections> or by visiting the offices of Electoral Services at Greenford Hall, Ruislip Road, Greenford UB6 9QN between 8.30am and 5pm on any working day.
6. Following the conclusion of this review, certain persons have a right to appeal by making representations to the Electoral Commission. The Commission will only consider representations where this review has failed to meet the reasonable requirements of the electors in the constituency or take sufficient account of the accessibility for disabled persons of a polling station within a designated polling place.
