

LB Ealing Polling District and Polling Place Review 2022
Comments and representations from public consultation
Considered at Boundaries Panel Meeting 4 November 2021

Representation 1 – received 26.09.21 - Mr French

I was quite surprised to read that my polling station next year will not be the Telfer Room in the Town Hall where I have voted for the past 27 years but in The Church of Christ the Saviour. This isn't classified apparently as a temporary polling station, but the Church would presumably receive a rental so it must be more expensive than the Town Hall at a time when budgets are under so much pressure.

I can't see any benefit to anyone for a move away from the Town Hall and it's likely to confuse an awful lot of people who have grown accustomed over the years to voting there. My question therefore is what is the reason?

I am copying this query to my local ward councillors and to the Chairs of the two RAs whose members will be affected by the change. I look forward to hearing from you.
