## PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN EALING ROAD AND TOWNHOLM CRESCENT

### The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. \*) Order 2021

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Ealing propose, to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to impose waiting restrictions applying "at any time" in the length of Ealing Road, Northolt specified in the Schedule to this Notice and waiting restrictions applying between 8am-10am, 1pm-3pm and 6pm-8pm on Mondays to Fridays in the length of Townholm Crescent specified in in the Schedule to this Notice. The Order would also bring the waiting restrictions in Maunder Road into line with the markings in that road

Townholm Crescent

the south-west side, between the common boundary of Nos. 67 and 69 Townholm Crescent and the common boundary of Nos. 85 and 87 Townholm Crescent
