1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing on the 8th March 2022 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Resident Parking Place Order will be to amend parking places in Queens Road and permitting 2 wheels on the footway parking between Nos. 121 and 159 Queens Road.

The general effect of the Waiting Amendment Order will be to remove 1 metre of waiting restrictions outside No. 56 Scott's Road.

 The general effect of the Disabled Persons Order will be to amend existing disabled parking places in Queens Road so that those outside Nos. 121 and 159 Queens Road are permitted to park with 2 wheels on the footway.
 The Orders, which will come into operation on

Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 19th April 2022.
