- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
- The general effect of the Waiting Amendment Order would be to vary the existing waiting restrictions for the purposes of loading or unloading so that they would apply at any time in the length of The Broadway specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
- The general effect of the Parking Place Order would be to remove the existing limited time parking places in The Broadway north to south arm and to provide an additional 5-minute maximum stay bay in a layby north of Metro Bank operating between 7am and 7pm on Mondays to Saturdays.
- 4. The general effect of the Loading Place Order would be to relocate the loading place in The Broadway north to south arm into a layby on the north-west side. The loading place would continue to operate between 10am and 4pm Mondays to Saturdays with a maximum stay of 20 minutes.
- 5. NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, under the powers of section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 propose to relocate the light controlled pedestrian crossing in The Broadway Ealing south of the east to west arm of Haven Green by 6.9 metres. The crossing area for pedestrians would be increased to 8 metres wide. The controlled area for vehicles would extend 16 metres on the north side of the crossing and 5 metres on the south side;
