- Rowdell Road will be closed at designated times as 2. illustrated in the schedule attached to this order 3
- Waiting, loading and unloading restrictions will be implemented on Belvue Road, Ealing Road & Rowdell Road for the entire or part lengths illustrated
- in the schedule attached to this order. 4
- Bus layby no entry ban on Mandeville Road will be lifted for event attendees only for the duration of the festival. Bus gate entry prohibition on Belvue Road will be lifted 5. for the duration of the event.
 - The above temporary restrictions and prohibitions
- will only apply at specified locations where appropriate traffic signs are provided and displayed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.
 - The waiting, loading and unloading restrictions will apply "At Any Time" to all vehicles wishing to park on the specified extent of Ealing Road, Belvue Road & Rowdell Road. These restrictions will be enforced with the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice and may also lead to the vehicle/s being relocated.
- While the temporary restrictions are in place, displaced vehicles should follow the diversions displayed in place 8 to reach their destinations and comply with any traffic management measures.

- Mandeville Road bus layby located on the northern extremity adjacent to Mandeville Parkway green space will have its no entry ban lifted for event attendees only for the duration of the Festival.
- Belvue Road bus gate which allows access to buses only will be lifted and will be open to all traffic in both directions for the duration of the Festival. 27th July until 7th August 2022
