- Effect of order 1. The order will close Oakwood Avenue and Milford Road, Southall at their junctions with Uxbridge Road. PLEASE NOTE that only one of these roads will be
 - closed at a time. 2. Whilst the closure is in force no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load or unload a vehicle in these lengths of road.
 - 3. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. Nothing in the proposed Order will apply to: -(a) anything done with the permission or at the
 - direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer: (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or
 - ambulance purposes; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works.

Date order will come into force 25th July 2022

Maximum duration of order

This order will expire on 17th January 2024, or upon completion of works whichever is sooner.
