- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing, on the 15th November 2022 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended to continue the Ealing (Provisions for the Re-Designation of Cycle Tracks and Various Exemptions (Electric Scooter Trial) Experimental Traffic Order 2021
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to in connection with electric scooters being used in a trial re-designate certain cycle tracks made pursuant to section 65 of the Highways Act 1980 as restricted carriageways and to exempt electric scooters being used in a trial from cycle lanes installed prior to when the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 came into force "Transport for London will permit the use of electric scooters on all GLA roads and side roads, where pedal cycles can already proceed, within the London Borough of Ealing from the date the Order comes into force. Any person desiring to guestion the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 27th December 2022.
