
ARTICLE 4 DIRECTION RELATING TO THE CHAPEL AND THE WEST LODGE AT ST BERNARDS HOSPITAL, UXBRIDGE ROAD, LONDON W7


The Council of the London Borough of Ealing being the appropriate local planning authority and being satisfied that it is expedient that certain specified developments should not be carried out on the buildings specified below (being buildings included in a list approved by the Secretary of State under Section 54 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971) unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf and acting in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 as amended

HEREBY DIRECTS that the permission granted by the said Order for development of Classes I (1) (3) (4) (5) and II (1) (2) (3) specified in Schedule I to the Order shall not apply to development of the buildings known as the Chapel and the West Lodge at St Bernards Hospital Uxbridge Road London W7

This Order shall come into force in relation to each building on the date on which notice thereof is served on the occupier of each property, or if there is no occupier, on the owner thereof
