- The general effect of the Bus Lane Order will be to extend the southbound bus lane in Yeading Lane by 14 metres.

Yeading Lane

- (a) the south-east side
 - between a point 114.00 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of the vehicular access leading to Dilston Close and Wells Close and a point 128.00 metres south-west of that kerb-line;
 - between a point 11.40 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Kingshill Avenue and a point 16.8 metres north-east of that south-western kerb-line;
- (b) the service road on the south-east side of Yeading Lane
 - the south-east side, between a point 1.9 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 416 and 418 Yeading Lane and a point 4.9 metres south-west of that common boundary;
 - (ii) the north-west side, between a point 3.35 metres north-east of a point opposite the south-western wall of No. 422 Yeading Lane and the north-eastern side of the gap in the service road opposite No. 412 Yeading Lane.
