## **PROPOSED PARKING/WAITING AMENDMENT IN BERRYMEDE ROAD**

**The Ealing (Bedford Park) (Residents Parking  
Places) (Amendment No. \*) Order 2022**  
**The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction)  
(Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. \*\*)**  
**Order 2022**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, in connection with a development in Berrymede Road, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to remove a 24.8 metres length of permit holder parking place in Berrymede Road on the north side outside No. 19.
3. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order would be to introduce waiting restrictions that would apply "at any time" in the length of Berrymede Road described in the Schedule to this Notice.
