## EALING BROADWAY DROP OFF BAY

### The Ealing (Free Parking Places) (No. 1, 2014) (Amendment No.\*) Order 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Parking Place Order would be to increase the operational hours of the 5 minute maximum stay bay in a layby north of Metro Bank so that it applies between 7am and 7pm on Mondays to Sundays.
