Reason for order

This Order is needed to facilitate line marking works in Uxbridge Road between the bus "U" turn and Greenford Road. Effect of order

- The Order will close the western side of the island site in Greenford Road at its junction with Uxbridge Road on Tuesday 14th February and Wednesday 15th February between 09.30 and 15.30.
- Whilst the closure is in force no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load or unload a vehicle in the closure area.
- The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. Nothing in the proposed Order will apply to: (a) anything done with the permission or at the
 - civil enforcement officer;
 (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or
 - ambulance purposes; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works.
