THE EALING (PERIVALE SCHOOL STREETS) (NO. 1) TRAFFIC ORDER 2023

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing propose, to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the Order would be to revoke and re-enact the Ealing (Perivale School Streets) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2022 so as to clarify for the avoidance of doubt the restrictions in Federal Road at the width restriction
  - (a) so that motor vehicles proceeding northbound on the western side of the Federal Road island site which have been issued with Perivale school SS1 permits can proceed through the restriction at all times;
  - (b) allow all motor vehicles to proceed southbound through the above width restriction except during school street hours;
