1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Waiting Amendment Order would be to
 - (a) impose waiting restrictions that would apply at any time in the length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
 - (b) remove waiting restrictions in Pitshanger Lane on the north side, between a point 29.3 metres east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Woodbury Park Road and a point 79.8 metres east of that kerb-line
3. The general effect of the Bus Lane Order would be to reduce the length of the eastbound bus lane in Uxbridge Road, Ealing Common by 18.2 metres.
4. The general effect of the School Keep Clear Order would be to provide a school keep clear marking outside the entrance to the North Ealing Primary School in Pitshanger Lane which would prohibit vehicles from stopping between 8.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays and between 3.00 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.
