THE EALING (BRENTSIDE SCHOOL STREETS) (NO. 1)

TRAFFIC ORDER 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing, on the 10th March 2023 has made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to create a pedestrian and cyclist zone for Brentside Primary School operating between **8.15am and 9.15am Mondays to Fridays, between 2.45pm and 3.45pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 2pm and 3pm on Fridays** in Elfwine Road, Hillyard Road - between Kennedy Road and Laurie Road and Kennedy Road - between Greenford Avenue and Cuckoo Avenue Residents living in the lengths of these roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice will be able to apply for a SS37 school streets zone permit to be issued for their vehicle so that they can access their properties during the above school street times.
3. The Order, which will come into operation on 13th March 2023, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order including plans, are available by e-mail from trafficnotices@ealing.gov.uk or by inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until the 21st April 2023.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 21st April 2023.
