## THE EALING (PERIVALE SCHOOL STREETS) (NO. 1) TRAFFIC ORDER 2023

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing on the 4th April 2023 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the Order will be to revoke and re-enact the Ealing (Perivale School Streets) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2022 so as to clarify for the avoidance of doubt the restrictions in Federal Road at the width restriction:
  - (a) so that motor vehicles proceeding northbound on the western side of the Federal Road island site which have been issued with Perivale school SS1 permits can proceed through the restriction at all times;
  - (b) allow all motor vehicles to proceed southbound through the above width restriction except during school street hours.
  - 3. The Orders, which will come into operation on 6th April 2023, other documents including plans giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available by either e-mailing <u>trafficnotices@ealing.gov.uk</u> or for inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until the 16th May 2023.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 16th May 2023.
