PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN WINDMILL LANE SOUTHALL

**The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction)
(Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. **)
Order 2023**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, to assist traffic flow and reduce congestion, propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to impose waiting restrictions that would apply at any time in the lengths of road described in the Schedule to this Notice. The restrictions on the east side formalise those in place.
