PARKING/WAITING AMENDMENT IN SOUTH PARADE

The Ealing (Parking Places) (Telephone Parking) (Bedford Park - Zone B) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2023 The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction)

(Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 875) Order 2023

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, in connection with a kerb build out to assist pedestrians, on 23rd May 2023 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
- 2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order will be to remove an 11.5 metre length of shared use parking (for permit holders and for up to 4 hours paid for parking) in South Parade on the south side opposite Ramillies Road
- 3. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order will be to introduce waiting restrictions that would apply "at any time" in the length of South Parade described above.
- 4. The Orders, which come into operation on 25th May 2023, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders including a plans, are available by e-mail from trafficnotices@ealing.gov.uk or by inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until the 4th July 2023.
- 5. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 4th July 2023.
