PROPOSED CYCLE EXEMPTION AT THE JUNCTION OF MILL HILL TERRACE WITH MILL HILL ROAD THE EALING (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. **)

TRAFFIC ORDER 2023

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Ealing (“the Council”) proposes to make the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to create a pedal cycle route through the closure at the southwestern extremity of Mill Hill Terrace and the north-eastern extremity of Mill Hill Road
