NOTICE OF INTENT TO CREATE A TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER AFFECTING MERRICK ROAD, SOUTHALL

Ealing Council intends to make the following temporary traffic order under section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

Title of order
This Order can be referred to as: Temporary Traffic Order MERRICK ROAD, SOUTHALL - 2023

Reason for order

This Order is needed to facilitate resurfacing works in Merrick Road and Healum Avenue.

Effect of order

- The Order will close Merrick Road between Its junctions with South Road and The Green and the Bridge Road roundabout. The closure would apply between 8.30am and 3pm on 7th August and 12th August.
- Whilst the closure is in force no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load or unload a vehicle in affected length of Merrick Road and Healum Avenue.
- The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. Nothing in the proposed Order will apply to: -
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
 - (c) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works.

Date order will come into force.

Maximum duration of order

This order will expire on 6th February 2025 or upon completion of works - expected on 12th August 2023 whichever is sooner.
