1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the abovementioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Doctor Parking Places and Northfields and South Ealing Amendment Order would be to convert two redundant doctor bays in Weymouth Avenue in permit holder parking for both South Ealing cpz S1 and Northfields cpz permit holders.
3. The general effect of the Zone C Parking Places Amendment Order would be to remove 5 metres of permit parking from Warwick Road outside the entrance to No. 1 Warwick Dene and replace it with at any time waiting restrictions.

All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and should include the address of the author.
