- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing ("the Council") proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 63 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the
- Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

 The general effect of the Bikehanger Order would be to provide for the installation of bikehangers in DENBIGH ROAD, the south-east side, north-east of the northern kerb-line of Waldeck Road; HARROW VIEW ROAD, W5, the west side, south of the common boundary of Nos. 31 and 33 Harrow View Road. Bikehangers are secure shelters for bicycles that are
 - 2.6 metres long and 2 metres wide.
 The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' Order would be to reduce in length a parking place in Denbigh Road to accommodate the introduction of the bikehangar.
