- Bikehangers are secure shelters for bicycles that are 2.6 metres long and 2 metres wide. The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' 3 Orders will be to reduce in length certain parking places in the roads listed in paragraph 2 above of this notice to accommodate the introduction of bikehangars
