## PROPOSED VILLIERS HIGH SCHOOL STREETS

### THE EALING (VILLIERS SCHOOL STREETS) (NO. 1) TRAFFIC ORDER 2023

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing, propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to create a pedestrian and cyclist zone for Villiers High School operating between **8.10am and 8.50am and between 2.30pm and 3.30pm on Mondays to Fridays** in Boyd Avenue and Villiers Road.
3. Residents living in the lengths of these roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice would be able to apply for a SS45 school streets zone permit to be issued for their vehicle so that they can access their properties during the above school street times.
