PROPOSED PARKING AMENDMENTS AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN EALING ROAD BY VILLAGE GREEN

The Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area)
(Amendment No. **) Order 2023

The Ealing (Parking Places) (Stop and Shop with additional Cashless Parking)
(No.1, 2022) (Amendment No. *) Order 2023

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
- These proposals are part of Visions for Northolt, Ealing Council will be carrying out highway improvement works along Ealing Road by the Village Green. Further information on this project can be found here <https://visionsfornortholt.co.uk/projects.html>
- The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order would be to (a) vary existing waiting restrictions so that they would apply at any time or (b) implement at any time waiting restrictions in the lengths of streets described in the Schedule to this Notice.
- The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to remove the existing echelon parking in Ealing Road and replace it with kerbside parking with a 30-minute limit of free parking. The operational hours of the parking places would be between 8 am to 6.30 pm Mondays to Saturdays and no return to the bays would be permitted for 1 hour.
Vehicles would be permitted to remain in these parking places beyond the 30-minute free parking period for an additional period of up to 2 hours on payment of a parking charge of between 70 and £1.40 per hour based on vehicle emissions. The parking charge would be payable through the telephone payment system operated by Paybyphone and would be required to be paid for by the end of the free parking period.

- NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Ealing Council, under the powers of section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to provide a new zebra crossing in Ealing Road to the north of Belvue Road. The controlled area for vehicles would extend 16 metres on both sides of the crossing. This crossing would have a parallel crossing for cyclists installed next to the zebra stripes.
- FURTHER NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN** that the London Borough of Ealing Council, under the powers of section 90c of the Highways Act 1980, propose to provide raised tables with a nominal height of 75 millimetres in Ealing Road. These will be situated (a) between a point 8.8 metres north of a point opposite the party wall of Nos.10 and 11 Station Parade. Ealing Road and a point 3.6 metres north of that party wall including ramps of 1.4 metres each. and (b) between a point 7.5 metres north of a point opposite the party wall of Nos.10 and 11 Station Parade. Ealing Road and a point 13.5 metres north of that party wall including ramps of 1.4 metres each.
- The proposed Orders, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders including the proposed crossings and raised tables including a plan, are available by e-mail from trafficnotices@ealing.gov.uk or by inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders.
- Any objections or other representations about either of the proposed Orders and the proposed zebra crossing and raised tables should be sent in writing by e-mail to trafficnotices@ealing.gov.uk or by post to Highways Service, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL, quoting reference ORD 4407 until the 1st November 2023. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and should include the address of the author.

Ealing Road

- The west side, between a point 14.00 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Belvue Road and a point 4.00 metres north of the party wall of Nos. 213 and 215/217 Ealing Road
