 - of Ealing ("the Council") proposes to make the above mentioned Order under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
 - 2. The general effect of the Waiting Amendment Order would be to introduce waiting restrictions which apply at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.
 - 3. The general effect of the Parking Orders would be to (a) remove a 14.2 metres length of permit holder parking in The Avenue, West Ealing outside Nos. 30 and 32; (b) remove the free parking place in Rowdell Road
- on the immediately south of Belvue Road both will be replaced with at any time waiting restrictions to ease traffic flow.
