- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
- The general effect of the Residents Parking Places Order would be to amend permit parking places in lengths of Enfield Road, Hanbury Road north of Enfield Road and Osborne Road (north-east side) so that they correspond with the layout on the ground.
- 3. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order would be to introduce new waiting restrictions that would apply "at any time". Amend waiting restrictions in lengths of Enfield Road and Osborne Road (south west side) so that they correspond with the layout on the ground
