- NOTICE IS HEREBY** GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing ("the Council") on 31st October 2023 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 63 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the Bikehanger Order will be to provide for the installation of bikehangers in.
  - ALLISON ROAD, the east side, o/s. 29 and 31;
  - BRIDGMAN ROAD, W4, the south-east side, o/s Nos. 18 and 20;
  - EMANUEL AVENUE, the north-east side, Nos. 9 and 11;
  - ESSEX ROAD, the south-west side, o/s Nos.6 and 8 Essex Road;
  - FRIARS PLACE LANE, Acton, the south-west side, near the south-eastern kerb-line of Perryn Road;
  - IVY CRESCENT, W4, the south-west side, o/s Nos. 23 and 25;
  - NEWBURGH ROAD, Acton, the south-west side, o/s Nos. 6 and 8 Newburgh Road, Acton;
  - PARK VIEW, W3, the north-west side, near the north-eastern kerb-line of Eastfields Road;
  - PETERSFIELD ROAD, Acton, the south-west to north-east arm, the south-east side, o/s Nos. 25 and 27;
  - WHELLOCK ROAD, the south side, o/s Nos. 79 and 81.Bikehangers are secure shelters for bicycles that are 2.6 metres long and 2 metres wide.
- The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' Orders will be to reduce in length certain parking places in the roads listed in paragraph 2 above of this notice to accommodate the introduction of bikehangars.
- The Orders, which come into operation on 2nd November 2023, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders including plans, are available by e-mail from [trafficnotices@ealing.gov.uk](mailto:trafficnotices@ealing.gov.uk) or by inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9:00am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until the 12th December 2023..
- Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 12th December 2023.
