The council are following the principle that providing six residents with cycle parking is a greater resident benefit than retaining parking space for one car. The installation of bike hangars is in line with Ealing's commitment to zero carbon emissions and supporting residents to cycle.

Ealing Council's response: We will proceed with installing a bike hangar outside 31/33 Harrow View Road. We have received 11 requests from the surrounding roads, while the nearest hangar to Harrow View Road is full and has 13 residents on the waiting list. We therefore assess that there is sufficient demand to justify the installation. If, after six months, the hangar is less than half full, we will undertake consultation to move it to a different location. During the consultation an alternative location on Albert Road was identified, but the number of requests is sufficiently high in the local area to support the installation of a hangar on this site in addition to Harrow View Road, at a later date.
