

6.4 Economy and sustainability

Functions delegated to the assistant director of leisure

Definitions

In this section the following definitions shall apply unless otherwise indicated:

- events, means events either on council owned or controlled premises or land or otherwise
- parks and countryside matters, includes matters relating to parks, allotments, leisure gardens, common land and other open spaces generally and any ancillary buildings, footpaths and bridleways

General

- 1.1 To take enforcement action (including the issuing of fixed penalty notices /penalty charge notices).
- 1.2 To authorise the service of any notices (and withdrawal), and the making of any orders required in the exercise of the council's functions.
- 1.3 To respond to consultations on policy issue, draft proposals, draft legislation and other street environment related issues.
- 1.4 To carry out any promotional activities to promote the functions of the Leisure team.
- 1.5 To charge, vary or waive a fee where there is a statutory power to do so.
- 1.6 To exercise the council's functions in respect of parks and countryside matters and events generally.

Policy/strategy

2. To develop and contribute towards the council's functions in respect of the preparation and development of appropriate strategies, policies and plans.

Arts, libraries, heritage, and leisure

Arts, heritage and libraries

- 3.1 To exercise the Council's functions in respect of its libraries and the promotion and provision of information and learning generally except as a local education authority.
- 3.2 To exercise the council's functions relating to the provision and promotion of arts and entertainment.
- 3.3 To manage and promote the use of the council's community centres.

Leisure and parks

- 3.4 To exercise the council's functions in respect of parks and countryside matters including but not limited to
 - 3.4.1 The definitive map and statement.

3.4.2 Allotments and smallholdings except insofar as such functions may not be exercised by officers.

3.4.3 The regulation of cemeteries including but not restricted to

- grants of burial and other associated rights (including extinguishment)
- applications for grave space and the erection of headstones, and
- the authorisation of commemorative planting and seats, plaques and inscriptions etc

3.5 To exercise the council's functions relating to the promotion of health, fitness and well-being.

3.6 To exercise the council's functions in respect of events.
