Examination of the Ealing Local Plan 2024-2039: An Update on Ealing LPA Community Infrastructire Levy (CIL)

You requested an update on the separate examination of the draft London Borough of Ealing Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Charging Schedule. The examiners final report was received on Friday 12th September and is published.

The report concluded that:

- the draft London Borough of Ealing Community Infrastructure Levy Charging Schedule provides an appropriate basis for the collection of the levy in the area;
- the Council has provided sufficient evidence that shows the proposed rates would not threaten delivery of the Local Plan; and,
- two modifications should be made to meet the drafting requirements, as set in Appendix 1 below.

You also requested a statement from the council as to any potential implications for the local plan examination arising from the CIL examiners report. These are that:

- the proposed rates have set a generous viability buffer to ensure that the CIL does not seriously threaten the delivery of development in the Borough (see Para 48) and
- the identified infrastructure requirements set out the IDP have been checked by the CIL examiner for reliability and accuracy as far as is necessary for CIL examination purposes (see Para 10).
