### Little Explorers

Session provides a stimulating environment for the transition from baby to two years old. A session for children aged 1-2 years, who have just started walking. The sessions are designed to inspire a sense of wonder and curiosity about the world around them. A range of puzzles, games and sensory activities to encourage the children to explore.

### Infant Massage

A hands-on 5-week course, designed to enhance bonding with your baby in a relaxed family environment. Each session is 1 hour long, and we learn new strokes each week. We repeat those strokes and build upon them until we can offer baby a full body massage by week 5. You will have the opportunity to learn a massage routine to ease colic, as well as the opportunity to talk about shared experiences with like-minded parents. Suitable for babies from newborn to pre-crawlers.



### Stay and Play (0-5 year olds)

We offer a diverse range of activities, including art materials, puzzles, educational games, sensory activities, role-play, and physical toys, all designed to help children learn and grow through play. Every activity is carefully planned to align with the children's interests, ensuring they enjoy a rich variety of learning opportunities while developing social skills and making new friends. Each session concludes with reading a story and singing rhymes, making it a fun and inclusive experience. We support parental involvement and development through observation and joint discussions. We provide personal support and information in a relaxing environment where parents/carers can connect with other families.

### Bumps to Babies (0-14mths)

A welcoming and supportive space for parents, expectant parents to connect and share their journey with babies aged 0-14mths. During this session, you will enjoy a relaxed environment where friendships can blossom and questions about your baby's development can be answered by friendly and qualified practitioners.

### Childcare funding

Check to see if you are eligible for any help towards the cost of your childcare. There are funding schemes available for families whose income is from work or receipt of benefits. Eligibility criteria apply.

Childcare is available for eligible working families for children aged 9 months – 4 years. You may be able to get:

- 15 hours a week if your child is 9 months to 2 years old
- 30 hours a week if your child is 3 to 4 years old

You must apply for a code by the end of the month before a new term starts and reconfirm your eligibility every 3 months to keep your code valid.

### CLCH Developmental Checks

If your child is aged between 8-12 months or 23-30 months, it is time to book a health and development check. It is your chance to find out about your child's development and speech and language. Find out about nutrition, toilet training, managing behaviour and immunisations. For booking please call admin hub on 020 8102 5888
