

Ealing Child Poverty Needs Assessment

Progress against National Indicators

Introduction

Part 2 of the Child Poverty Act places a duty on local authorities and named partner authorities to cooperate with a view to reducing, and mitigating the effects of, child poverty in their local areas. This cooperation will involve producing a local child poverty needs assessment which will enable local partners collectively to understand better the distribution and characteristics of child poverty across their local areas and the extent and nature of the local challenge.

The needs assessments will provide the evidence base for the production of local child poverty strategies, which are also required by Part 2 of the Act.

What are statistical neighbours?

Statistical Neighbours

Statistical Neighbours are the ten other Local Authorities that, for any single local authority, have the greatest similarity of values for a given set of socio-economic indicators. Data for the full set of statistical neighbours are displayed in the graphs that accompany the reports.

The purpose of statistical neighbours

Each Local Authority can compare its performance against other Local Authorities deemed to have similar socio-demographic characteristics (its statistical neighbours) rather than comparing itself with local authorities that share none (or few) of its characteristics. The statistical neighbour mean simply provides the mean** of the ten most comparable local authorities considered.

*** Mean average at the individual level, calculated by aggregating all the Local Authorities pupils together and then calculating their mean value for a given indicator (e.g. Percentage of children with good level of development).*

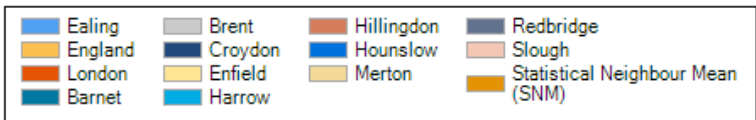
NI 74 - Achievement at level 5 or above in both English and Maths at Key Stage 3 (%), 2007

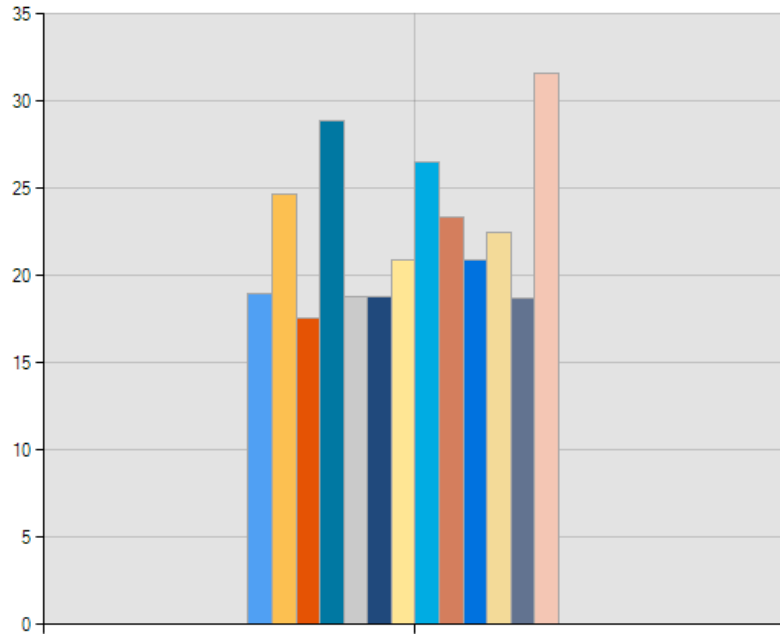

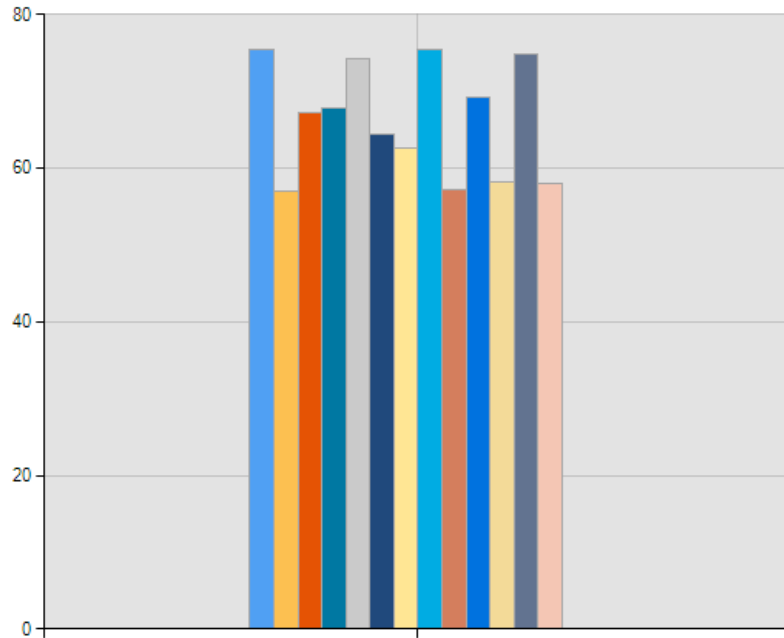




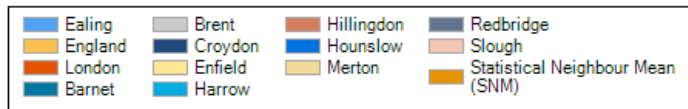
NI 81 - Inequality gap in achievement of a level 3 qualification by age 19 (%), 2008



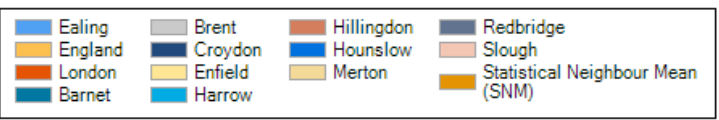
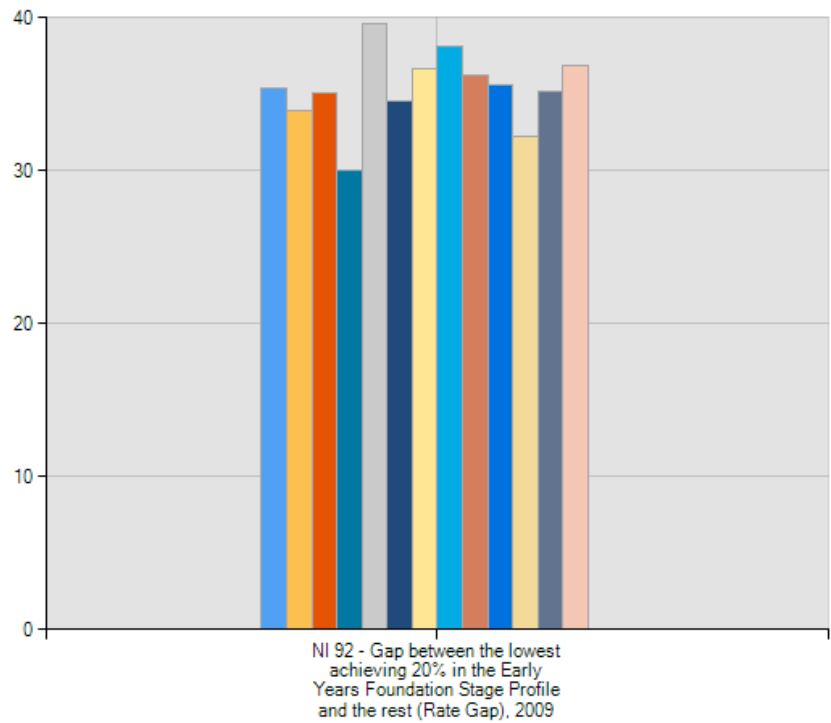

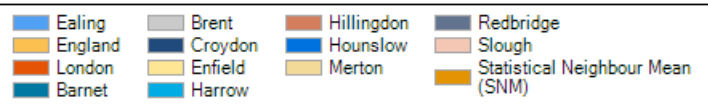
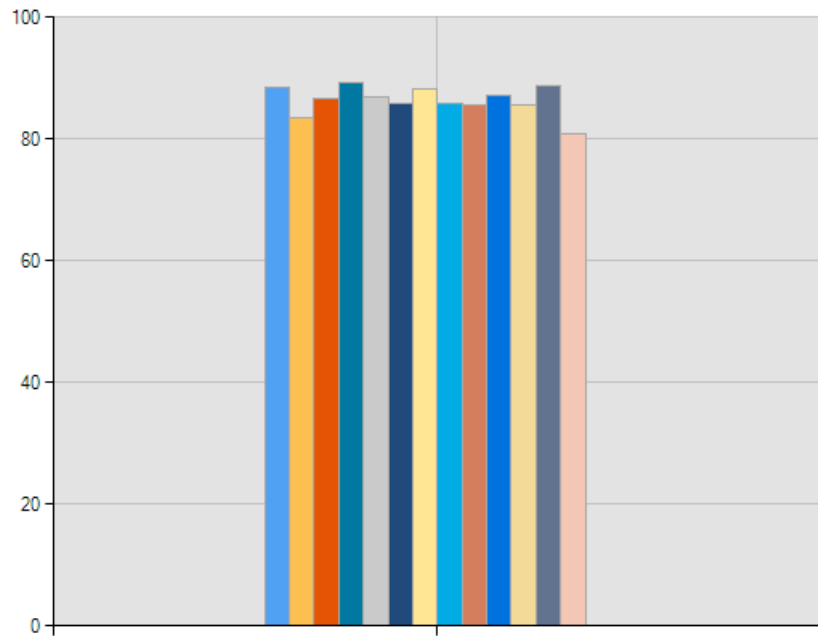
NI 82 - Inequality gap in achievement of a Level 2 qualification by age 19 (%), 2008



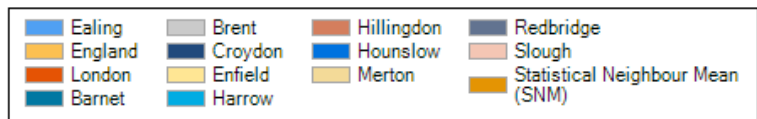
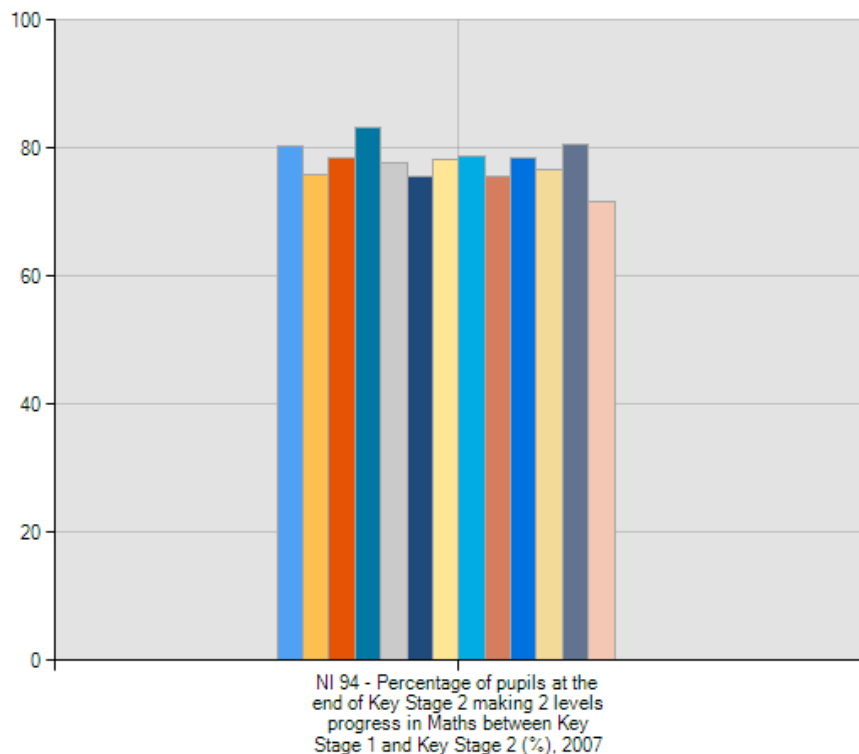

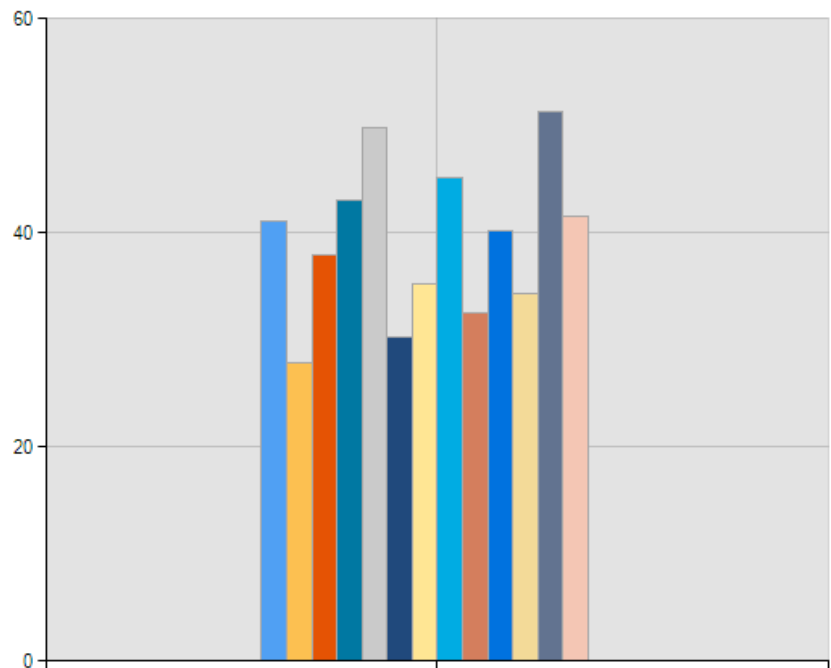




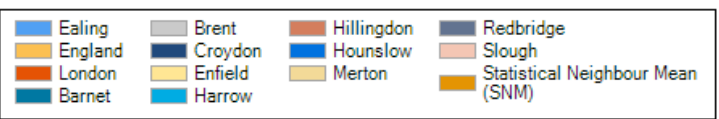
NI 97 - Pupils making 2 levels progress between Key Stages 3 and 4 in English (%), 2007



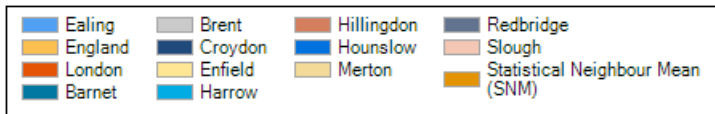
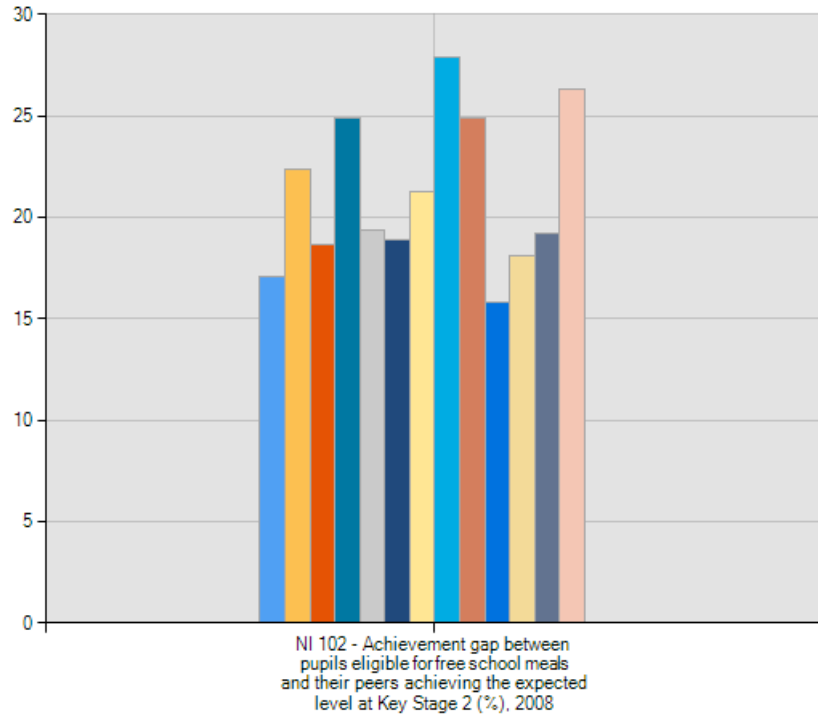

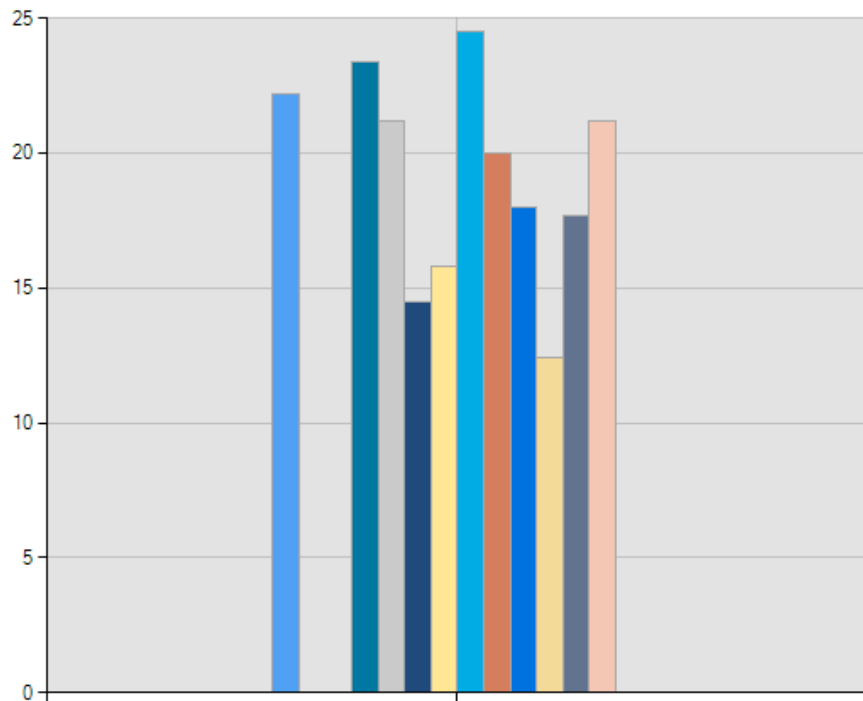
NI 98 - Pupils making 2 levels progress between Key Stages 3 and 4 in Maths (%), 2007



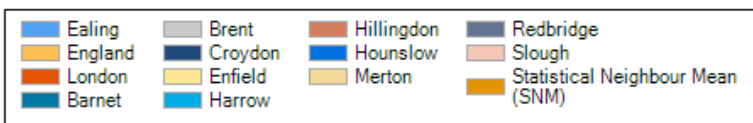

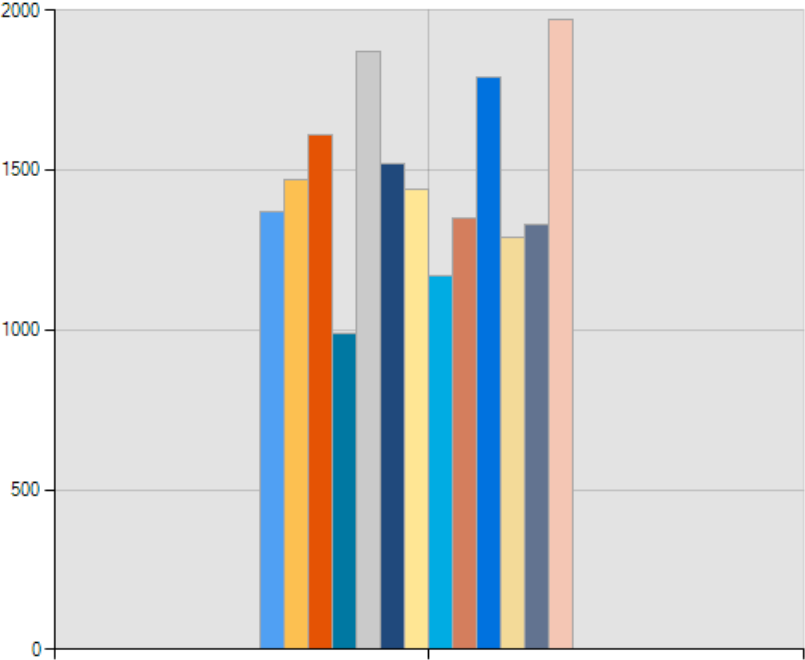


NI 106 -Young people from low income backgrounds progressing to higher education (%), 2007

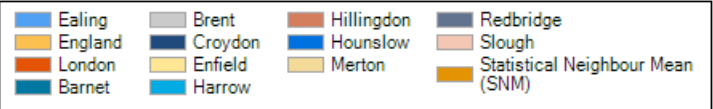

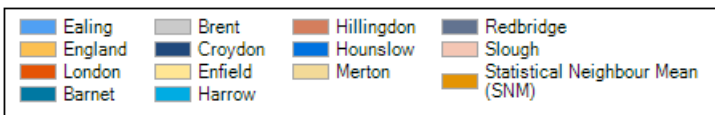
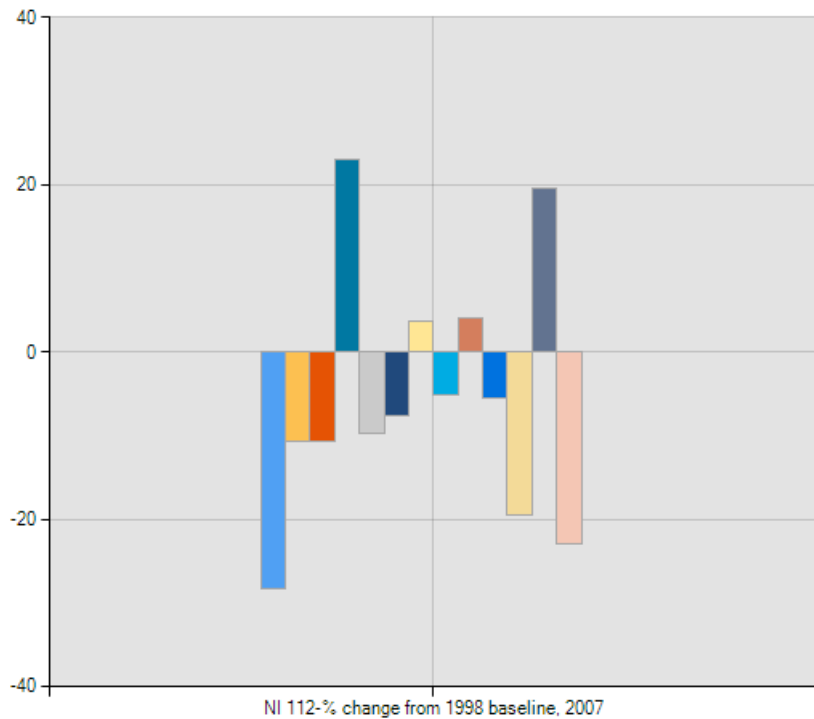

NI 111 - First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System aged 10-17, 2009

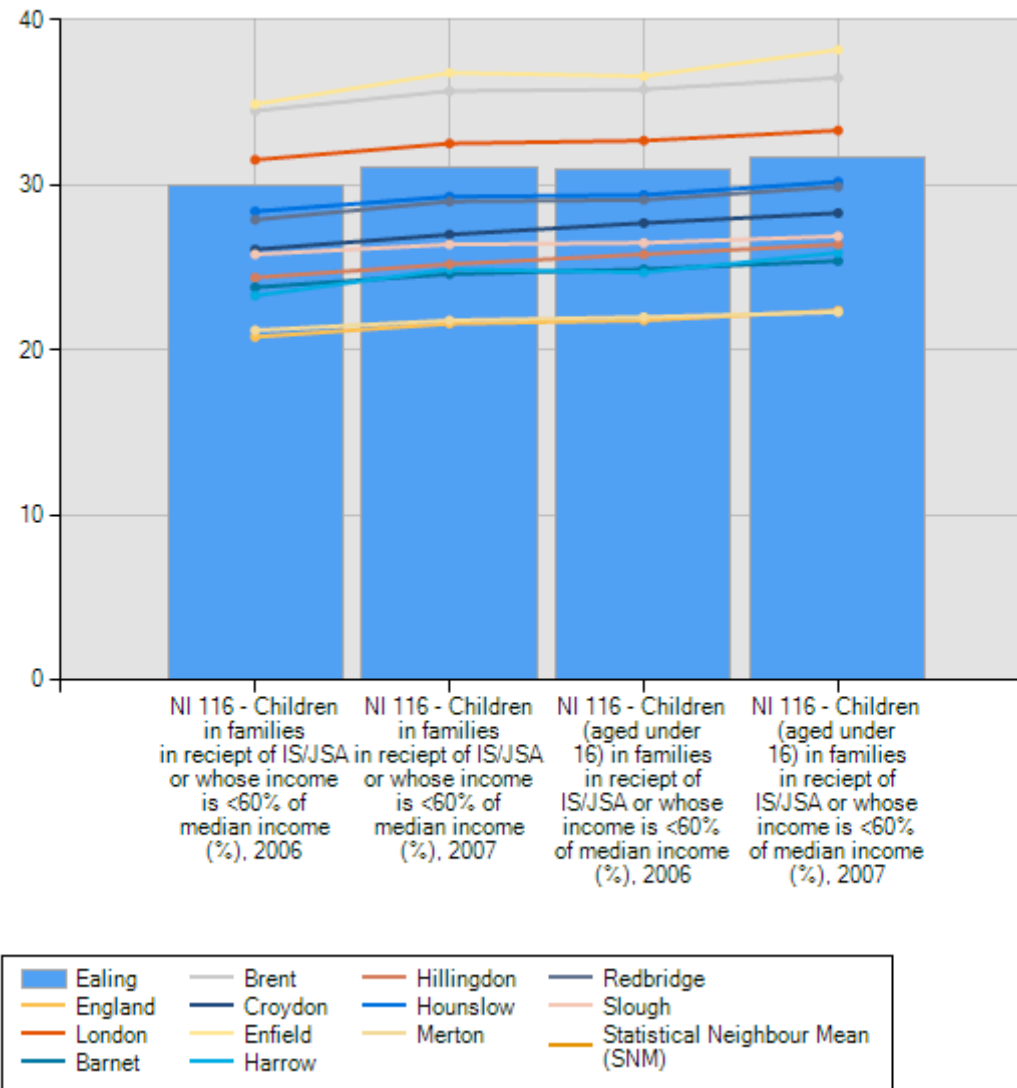

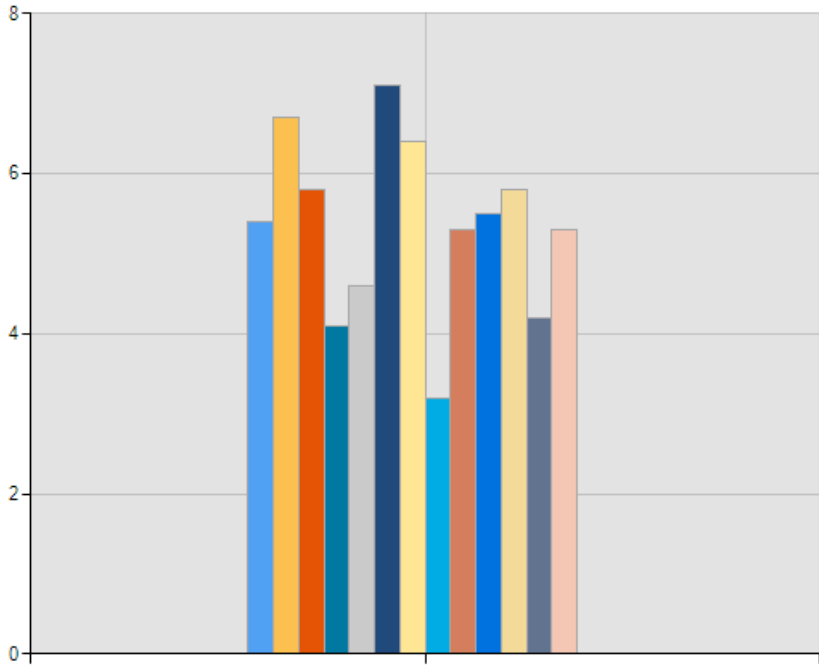


NI 166 - Median earnings of employees in the area (Earnings), 2010

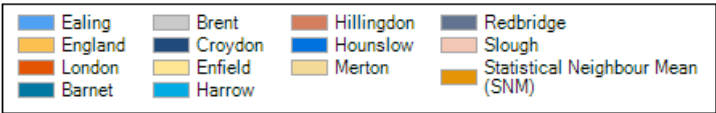

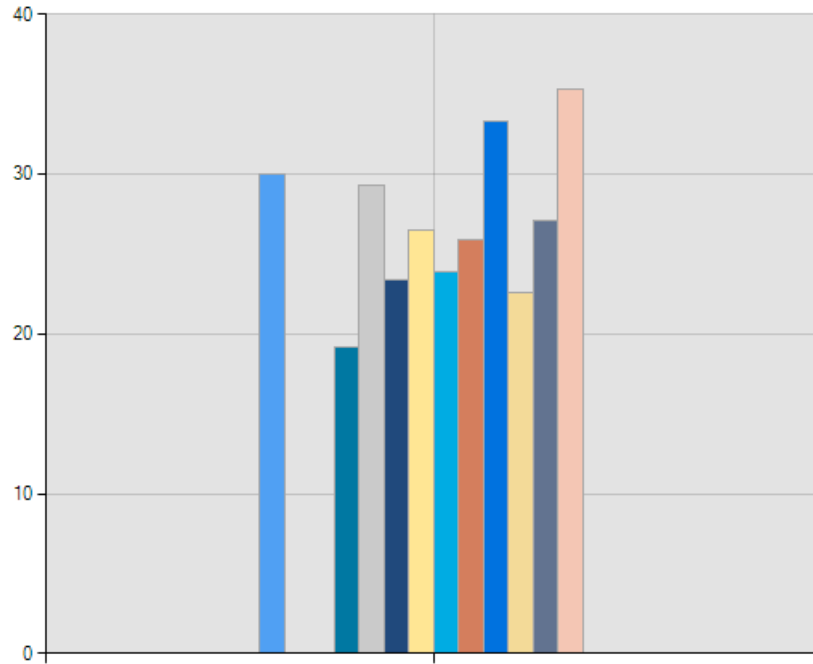


NI 118 - Take up of formal childcare by low-income working families (%), 2008

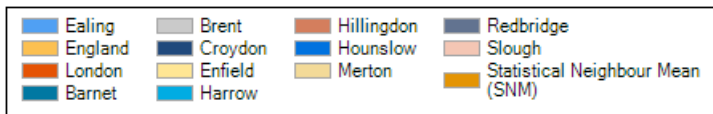

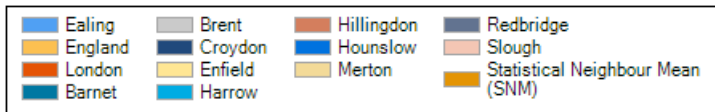
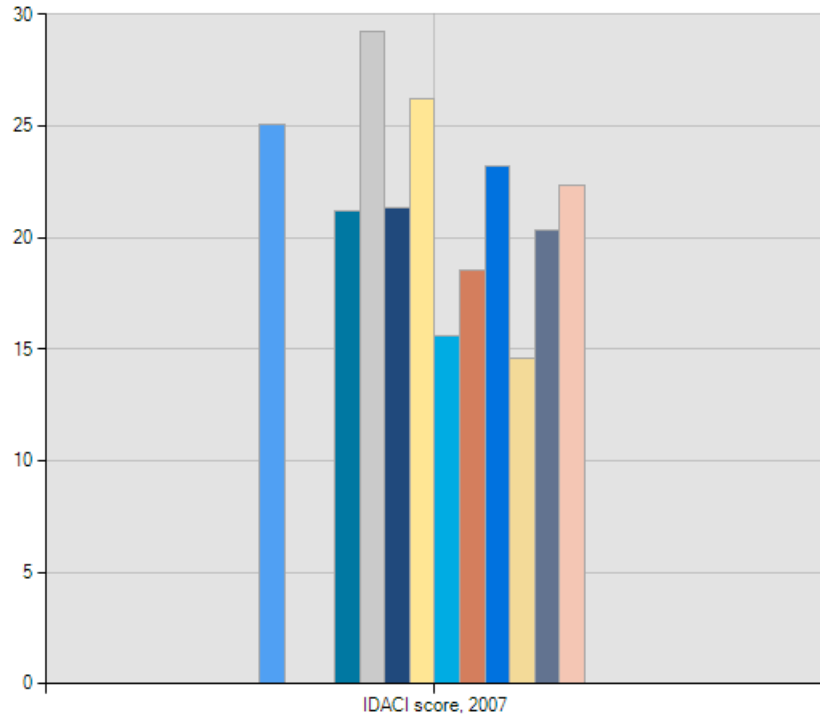
NI 17 - Percentage who think that anti-social behaviour is a problem in their local area (%), 2008
