

London Borough of Ealing Statutory Notice for a proposal to establish a Specialist Resourced Provision at Acton Gardens Primary School.

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013/3110 that London Borough of Ealing intends to make prescribed alterations to Acton Gardens Primary School, 232 Osborne Rd, London W3 8SR from 1st September 2027.

The London Borough of Ealing proposes to permanently establish a Specialist Resourced Provision (SRP) for up to 36 pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan aged 4 to 11 (pupils will be admitted incrementally from 2027). SRPs provide placements for children and young people who require higher levels of specialist support and provision to meet their needs and to access learning and the mainstream curriculum. The proposed SRP will require investment in the school building on the Acton Gardens Primary School site. The cost for works at the site to accommodate the 36 pupils is estimated at £1 million. Funding will be from the council's capital programme for special needs places. The implementation of the provision is anticipated to assist with containing costs within the High Needs budget.

It is not anticipated that the proposed SRP at Acton Gardens Primary School will have any impact on other educational facilities within the local area. The proposal has been made to accommodate demand for SRP places. Admissions to the SRP will be coordinated by the Local Authority, based on the provision stipulated in a pupil's Education, Health and Care Plan.
